## **JOB DESCRIPTION OF SANITATION WORKER**

### **POSITION DESCRIPTION FUNCTION**

The sanitation worker is responsible to the leadman and is exclusively responsible for the collection and disposal of solids wastes from all domestic, municipal and commercial businesses in Raymond. The worker shall determine when the truck is loaded and haul the load to the transfer station for unloading.

The sanitation worker is also responsible for maintaining collection equipment, including the truck, packer unit and solid waste dumpsters. The sanitation worker functions as a one man operation and performs all of the sanitation duties individually. If the sanitation worker needs assistance he seeks it through the leadman.

As with all public works crew members the sanitation worker's position may involve assignments by the leadman when events mandates that crew members are required to address events in the water distribution, sanitary sewers, storm water and streets to eliminate safety hazards to the public. During such events the worker will be required to perform independently or with a crew taking the initiative to complete the work in a safe, orderly and high quality manner. The sanitation worker is required to work on all legal holidays.

### **Examples of Work**

- Collects solids wastes.
- Performs routine mechanical work and maintenance of collection equipment and dumpsters.
- Maintains truck, packer and dumpsters in a clean and safe condition with timely wash downs on the vehicle wash rack.
- Coordinates needed mechanical work on equipment through the leadman.
- Maintains records on solid waste volumes and equipment maintenance as required.
- Performs related work required, and as directed by the leadman.
- Assists with other public works projects as needed to eliminate safety hazards to the public.

- Drives the sanitation truck in a safe and orderly manner and maintains a courteous driving manner.
- Remove and replace lids to containers after placing contents into truck and place the containers in the locations when picked up. Make certain that dumpster lids are closed after dumping.

### **Knowledge, Abilities and Skills**

- Knowledge of solid waste schedule and routine.
- Knowledge of the working hazards and the applicable safety precautions associated with the working routine and conditions of each route.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions, as well as the initiative and responsibility to pursue tasks from concept to completion.
- Physical strength and agility sufficient to perform the heavy manual labor for extended periods under favorable and unfavorable weather conditions.
- Ability to operate the equipment utilized in the position of sanitation worker.
- Knowledge of truck mechanics and maintenance.
- Ability to keep accurate and clear records of work.
- Ability to establish and maintain open and effective working relationships with the public, co-workers and supervisors.
- Be cognizant that the sanitation worker's position is also a public relations position in meeting the public.

### **Education and Qualifications**

- Graduation from high school or equivalent.
- Washington State Driver's License.
- Washington State Commercial Driver's License.
- Ability to listen and communicate with people.
